RE: Redistricting Recommendation for Battle Creek Schools

Redistricting is necessary with the opening of the new Battle Creek schools for the start of school in 2019. These schools are being opened to address the population growth in Northern Maury County. The redistricting recommendations are as considered by the Redistricting Task Force in the fall of 2019. One change has been made. The new recommendation includes redistricting some students from Spring Hill Elementary school to Marvin Wright Elementary School. This is due to the growth seen this year in Spring Hill Elementary students and the new housing starts in the Spring Hill High School Zone.

The numbers projected here match the maps that have been provided for the opening of Battlecreek Elementary and Middle Schools. Please note the "Current Enrollment" numbers are based pm 10/18/18's actual enrollment. "Projected Enrollment" numbers reflect ACTUAL students in each zone. Projected Numbers do not take into account OOO or SPED assignments as those are virtually unpredictable based on student location and movements.

This is based on adding the new schools into the mix, RHES, CMS, SHMS zones were not expanded.

The MP proposed changes are included as this would simply make MPES's zone match both MPMS and MPHS. This has been requested by numerous parents in the areas impacted. This change would impact the Zion area and Campbellsville Pike areas. It would move 24 and 29 students from Brown and Woodard respectively to MPES.
